Practice and share on discussion board



In this student discussion activity, we will be visiting the [w3schools.com](https://www.w3schools.com) and going through some of the **CSS Tutorial "Try It Yourself"** outlined below.

You will then apply formatting and styling on your web page you created in the Module 1 assignment. You will add an internal style sheet and/ or inline style rules for your web page.

Step 1: Initial Posting (2 Requirements)

1. Open the web page you created in Module 1 in the Text Editor.
You will be inserting an internal style sheet **and/or inline style rule**.

NOTE: The minimum requirement is to add style rules for the [text color](#), [font type](#) and page [background color](#) to your web page.

2. Below are the tips/ guidance in formatting and styling your web page:
 - You can also create and apply additional style rules for your web page.
 - To create the internal style sheet, insert `<STYLE> </STYLE>` tags within the `<HEAD>` tag of your web page. See [Module 3D - Creating an Internal Style Sheet](#)

- To create an inline style, insert within the opening tag, the attribute and value STYLE="property: value;". See [Module 3E - Apply an Inline Style Rule](#)
- Save your HTML document containing the internal style sheet and/ or inline style rule.

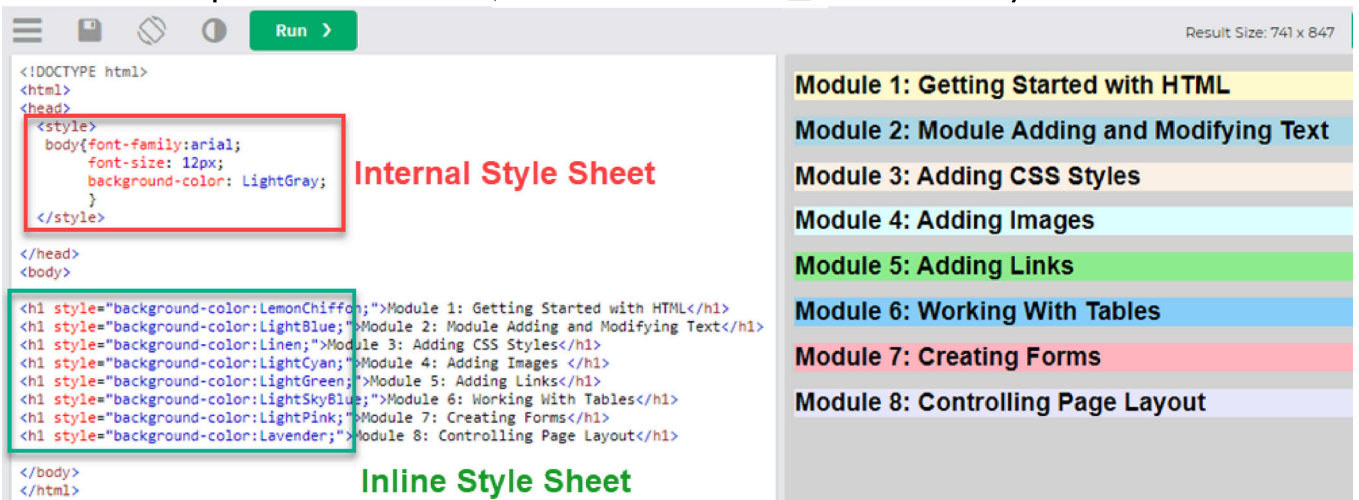
3. First Requirement:

Post a screenshot of your web page output displaying in the browser with the applied style rules - text color, font-type and background color.

4. Second Requirement:

Post at least three screenshots to share with the class of the "Try it Yourself" CSS tutorials you ran with edits to style rule properties and text content.

- Edit the style rule property values before clicking on the Run button. You can be creative by editing the text content you like to use.
- The screenshots that you post should have the HTML/ CSS code and web page output (see below).

Step 2: Student Peer Replies

1. Respond to at least two of your classmate's postings in 25 -50 words.
2. In your reply, note what stands out on your classmate's postings.
3. You can also reply to any common learnings of our classmates when going through the CSS tutorials "Try it Yourself".
